What to expect

Once you choose us we will begin by learning as much about you as possible.

As soon as we have a date fixed for your wedding day shoot we can begin planning engagement session if you wish to do those. It's such an exciting time in your life and we want to make sure that we can learn all about you both and your story. So, that you day is relaxed, fun and really the best day ever.

On your day- YEAH it's here!!! We will arrive at your wedding location early and begin scouting the venue, talking to the staff & other vendors. Also, to take detail shots prior to the ceremony. As the day progresses we will ensure that we cover all the photographs planned on our timeline beginning from the getting ready all the way to your nighttime shots and everything in between. In the days following, we will edit photos, post some teasers, and about 6 weeks after upload your photos to an online gallery so that you can share them with all your family and friends. We will also begin preparing any products you wish to order including albums, prints, wall art etc. It's truly our goal capture your wedding day memories so that you can cherish these moments for a long time to come!






- Be sure to have a hair and makeup trial at least a month before your wedding.

 This will give you peace of mind to know exactly how you will look and give you
 the opportunity to change things in advance if necessary.

 Make sure to bring all jewelry to the trial to see how makeup shades work with the pieces.
- Have your florist deliver your flowers to where you are getting ready, not the ceremony venue. Since you never know when the mood will strike for a great photo, you'll want your flowers ready.
- Find out what the rules for photographs are at the ceremony location. All venues are different, some restricting the location of photographs and even the times in which they are permitted.
- Consider shooting your formal photographs before the ceremony. Getting this step out of the way early in the day frees up time to spend with your guests. You will be able to go straight to cocktail hour after family photos catch up with loved ones . It's a new age, so it's no longer considered bad luck for the groom to see the bride before the wedding.
- Have food delivered to your getting ready location. It may be hectic, but take the time to have a bite before the wedding since it will be a while before you have the opportunity to nourish yourself during the reception.
- Prepare an emergency bridal kit with clear nail polish, mints, a sewing kit, stain treater, Visine, safety pins, bobby pins, pain reliever and mini deodorant.
- Allowing 20% more time for hair and makeup than you originally anticipated alleviates the number one reason wedding schedules end up running late. Also, as the bride ask to go first so that you are done and can start photos, where as a bridesmaid can be running a little a later.
- Make sure you discuss a "rain plan" with your venue just in case Mother Nature doesn't see sunshine in the cards.

Timeline

It is important to have a list of who you want to have photographed at the wedding. We recommend asking both parents who they would like to have photos of. As we all know this is one of those few times everyone is together. Take advantage of the special day and make sure you get those important grandparents and generations images. This is your history taking place and these photos will have captured if for the generations to come.

Here is a sample timeline of a typical wedding, that will help to give you an idea of what you can expect:

- Getting ready pictures of bridge & groom.
- The first look of bridge & groom
- On location with the bridal party
- The wedding ceremony
- Group shot of entire wedding
- Family and important people photos

- Bridal party photos & bride & groom
- The bridal party enters reception
- Reception dinner, any speeches and/or toasts
- The cake being cut, possible sunset photo
- The first dances of husband and wife
- Any additional photos such as the sparklers
